MATHS NEWS

- Year 11 Maths.** The Maths department is focusing on the implementation of the new Year 11 curriculum. This process impacts on all year levels up to Year 11 as we continually prepare all our students with the skills and resilience needed, to engage with Senior Studies. Year 11 students are now preparing for an assessment item that contributes to 50% of the years result. This exam will cover all class content from January to September. This is a great challenge for both students and teachers. Parents must ensure their child is revising class work each night and completing all homework set to ensure the best possible outcome for their child.

Teams of five including some of our finest Year 7 mathematicians competed in a series of mathematical games, challenges and exercises.
