2. SETPLAN Interviews

The completion of the **Senior Education and Training (SET) Plan** is an integral step in ensuring students have made educated decisions about their choices in the senior phase of learning, in order to achieve their career goals and aspirations.

A vital component in promoting the success of these SET Plans is the involvement of families in the final decision-making process. Caloundra State High School acknowledges the need for a collaborative plan to be developed and as such will be organising SET Plan interviews for all year 10 students in Week 5, Term 3.

Interview Details

- Interviews will be 15mins in length and are a **compulsory requirement** for enrolment in Year 11
- Booking information will be made available on the **4th August 2021**.
- Bookings are to be made with a teacher offering your child's preferred pathway. Pathways include: University, Certificate (e.g. TAFE/RTO), Apprenticeships/Traineeships, Employment and Australian Defence Force.

Year 10 Classes Suspended

Year 10 classes will be suspended throughout the SET Plan interview period. Year 10 classes be suspended from Tuesday 10th August and recommence on **Thursday 12th August**. Where families are unable to provide home supervision arrangements for their child, students will be able to attend school and join a private study classroom, supervised by a teacher. No new learning will take place during these study classrooms.

With the support of school staff, students are expected to have completed their SET Plan online through OneSchool prior to the interview. The purpose of this interview is to review and modify the plan if necessary and for all parties to agree and sign off on the final subject selection and pathway for senior phase of learning. Due to the time constraints, students who have not completed a sufficient amount of the SET Plan may be required to rebook an interview at a later date.

COVID Requirements:

- Stay at home if you are unwell or have a cough, fever, fatigue, sore throat or shortness of breath.
- Attendees are required to use the hand sanitiser stations when entering the school grounds.
- Sign in using Check in Queensland QR code at the entry door, via the [Check in QLD app](#).
- Guests **must** maintain 1.5m physical distancing between each family group at all times.
- All guests are required to depart school grounds immediately at the end of the event.
- Guests will be required to wear a mask at all times, if they are still mandated.
