



Q: WILL MY STUDENT BE ABLE TO PRINT FROM THEIR IPADS?

No, but if they have a laptop for their BYO device they will have full access to the school network including printing. Students will still have access to school devices and will be able to email themselves content from their iPads that they can then print from a school computer.

Q: IS THE INTERNET FILTERED?

Yes, while the student is using the school internet wireless service it is filtered using Blue Coat filtering. When at home or off the school network, internet access is not filtered by DETE, this is the responsibility of the parents/guardians.



Q: ARE THERE ANY DEVICES THAT CAN NOT CONNECT TO THE SCHOOL NETWORK?

Unfortunately Windows RT, iPad Mini, Android Devices, Chromebook, Windows machine with 64GB storage or less and Linux OS devices are not able to connect to the school network.

Q: IS IT NECESSARY TO PURCHASE AN ANTI-VIRUS SOFTWARE?

There is no requirement to purchase an Anti-virus software package as the most current operating systems have built in capabilities.

DOES THE DEVICE NEED MOBILE DATA CAPABILITY?

MIDDLE AND SENIOR SECONDARY (YR 9-12) JUNIOR SECONDARY(OPTION 2)

A laptop computer from any of the numerous companies that sell these devices, as long as the minimum specifications below are met.

WHAT ARE THE MINIMUM SPECIFICATIONS?

- 4GB RAM
- 128GB SSD/HDD/eMMC or higher.
- intel i3, Quad-Core or equivalent.
- Windows 10, Apple OS10.7 or higher.
- External Drive for backup purposes.

WHAT DO ALL DEVICES REQUIRE?

In order to connect and function within the school network:

- Wireless connectivity
- Remove any trial antivirus software
- MS Office - Students enrolled in State School education can download free of charge.
