

# Investing for Success

## Under this agreement for 2017

### Caloundra State High School will receive

**\$421,700\***

#### This funding will be used to

- Increase the engagement of middle secondary students as demonstrated by increased attendance (90%), improved A - C academic results and reduced behaviour incidents.
- Provide programs for students at risk of disengagement (red zone) in order for them to re-engage into schooling.
- Provide professional learning for teachers in the areas of student engagement and Information and Communication Technology integration in teaching.
- Increase the percentage of exiting students who enter higher education, training or employment from 87% to 90%.

#### Our initiatives include


- Employment of a Middle Secondary Head of Department.
- Employment of a part time Vocational Placement Officer and full time Attendance Officer.
- Employment of an Indigenous teacher aide to support student learning.
- Development of a school based Alternative Program to provide programs for students at risk of disengaging.
- Provision of professional development to staff to improve teaching practice in the digital learning area.
- Employment of an Industry Liaison Co-ordinator (A05) to manage the Trade Training Centre.
- Employment of a technician to provide digital learner support (T04).

#### Our school will improve student outcomes by

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| • Monitoring and following up student non-attendance so all students are at school and learning.  | \$82,424  |
| • Providing support for students at risk of dis-engaging from schooling through creation of an alternative program in order to re-engage students to ensure success with learning.  | \$14,232  |
| • Targeting Year 9 and Year 10 students who are the most at risk with attendance, behaviour and Outcomes, by establishing a recognizable middle secondary sub school with a Head of Department responsible for Year 9 and Year 10, to increase school engagement. | \$137,953 |
| • Providing pathways to employment, education or further training through student vocational placement and access to certificate level trade courses through the Trade Training Centre.   | \$9,360   |
| • Securing direct links to employment through students completing trade level certificates at the Technical Training Centre.  | \$83,321  |
| • Closing the Gap between Indigenous and Non-Indigenous students through student support.   | \$15,912  |
| • Improving teaching practice, Information and Communication Technology integration into learning and student engagement through teacher professional development.  | \$3,231   |
| • Providing all digital learners (staff and student) with support to engage with 21 <sup>st</sup> Century learning.   | \$75,267  |



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
