CRITERIA	EXPLANATION
ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT	You must include in your application: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• a copy of your most recent reports, signed by the Principal of your school e.g. Semester 2 School Report 2020.
CONDUCT	Your conduct in all school activities must be exemplary at all times. If your most recent report does not comment on your behaviour you need a letter from your classroom teacher, counter-signed by the Principal, confirming your standard of behaviour.
LEADERSHIP	You must demonstrate that you are a positive role model to your peers. Please outline your leadership experiences – e.g. School captain, captain of a sports team, leadership positions within your classroom and/or community.
