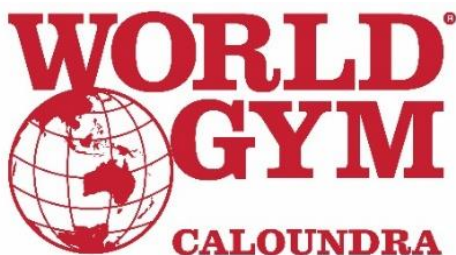
QParents Registration
