## VETIS

- If your Year 10-12 child is completing a certificate with an outside provider (RTO), they may be using their VETIS funding. VETIS funding is funding from the Government enabling students to complete courses free of charge (money is paid to the RTO). A student can only use VETIS funding once. Students attending the Trades Training Centre may use VETIS funding or pay the full cost of the course. If you are interested in attending the TTC or completing a Hospitality or Business Certificate in Year 11 or 12, you must not use your VETIS. ## ILLNESS AND MISADVENTURE

- All students must attend scheduled exams. If a student is ill or a major event has occurred preventing them from attending an exam the following form must be submitted to the Head of Department for the exam missed. This form is not to be used if your student is missing an exam due to a family holiday or other unauthorised absences.
