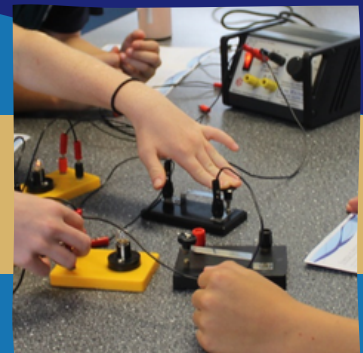
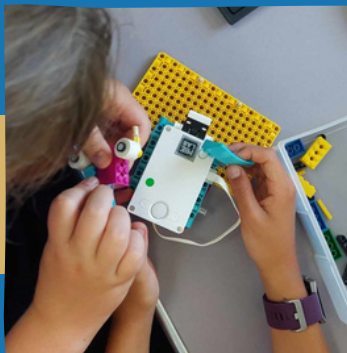

OVERVIEW

Caloundra State High School is offering an exciting opportunity for upper primary school students to participate in the **Bright Futures** academic extension program. This after school program will run for 12 sessions over four terms, offering year 5 and year 6 students the chance to access specialist facilities while engaging in academically rigorous challenges utilising and developing 21st century skills.

This selective entry program is strictly limited in numbers to allow targeted development of collaboration skills, critical and creative thinking, communication, personal and social skills and ICT skills. Workshop opportunities will utilise an inquiry and investigation framework, building capacity for students considering applying for the Horizons academic excellence classes in 2026.

APPLICATION

To apply, return the completed application form and supporting documentation via email to juniorsecondary@caloundrashs.eq.edu.au or in person to Caloundra State High School by **Friday 14th June 2024**.

REQUIREMENTS

- Participants will be required to pay a one off \$85 enrolment fee. This fee covers the cost of all materials used, and a **Bright Futures** t-shirt to wear identifying students as part of the program.
- As a collaborative program, students are required to attend all scheduled sessions, notifying of illness or absence.

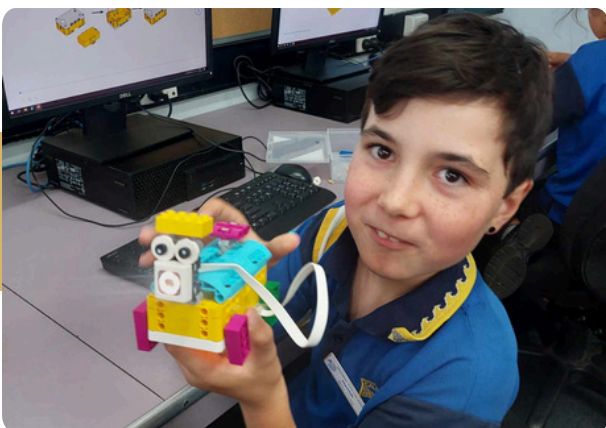
Features of the Bright Futures include:

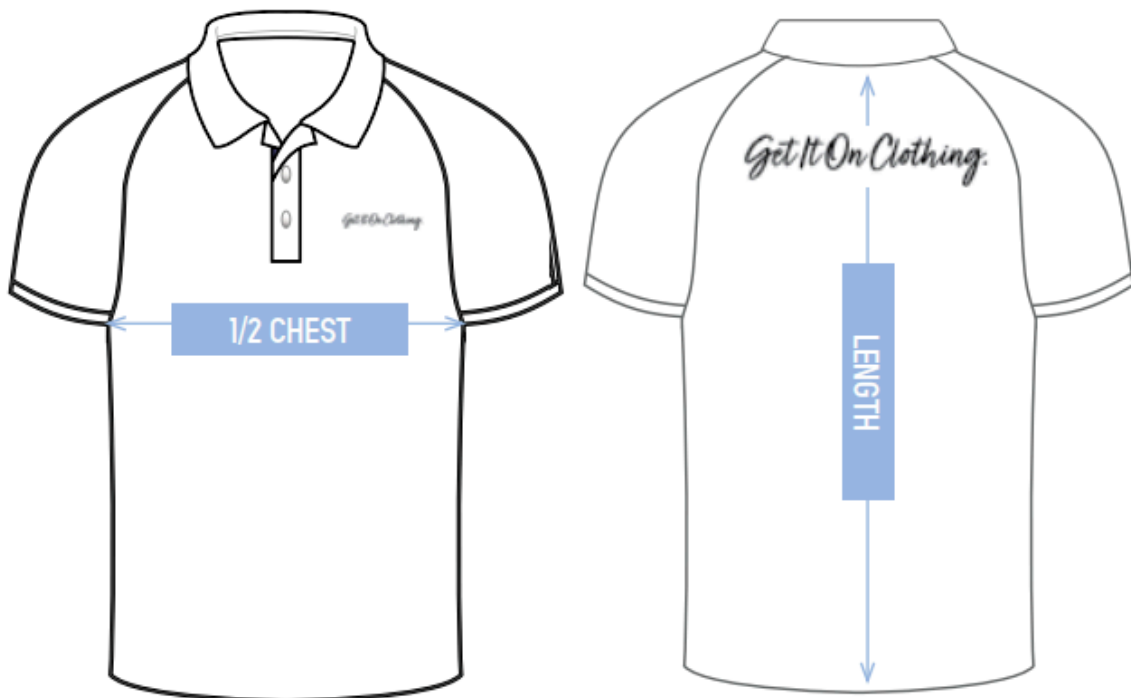
