Caloundra State High School offers Arts Performance Signature Programs in dance and music pursuits that are designed to assist students in reaching their potential. As each program requires a significant commitment of time and effort, students can only participate in one Arts Performance Signature Program so that they can experience the full benefit of the program. These programs require a significant commitment of time and effort outside of school hours. Entry to all Arts Performance Signature programs is by application and audition. Details about each program are as follows:

### Dance Performance

The Caloundra State High School Dance Performance Program is open to students in year 7–10 and is designed to provide talented dance students, who have a genuine interest and passion for dance with technical and choreographic training. The course will provide students with a range of dance experiences in a variety of dance styles and will enhance their personal and dance ability in performance (Jazz, Hip Hop, Contemporary, Lyrical, etc). Students will have the opportunity to represent Caloundra State High School in dance competitions and eisteddfods. This program has a uniform fee for the first year in the program and fees annually for costumes and choreography.

The students have the opportunity to be involved in Junior EDGE Dance Troupe (year 7-9) and Senior EDGE (year 10-12). Junior and Senior EDGE produce dances in a variety of styles including Jazz, Lyrical, Contemporary and Hip Hop. Junior EDGE rehearses for 1 1/2 hours either before or after school and Senior EDGE for 2 hours afterschool each week.

The Dance Performance course is designed to:

- Promote extension and enrichment activities in dance
- Develop performance and choreographic skills in numerous dance styles
- Encourage leadership and collaboration
- Develop creativity and critical thinking skills

### Music Performance

The Caloundra State High School Music Performance Program is open to students in year 7–10 and is designed to provide talented music students, who have a genuine interest and passion for music an opportunity to extend their music ability in areas of performance, composition and analysis of music. The course will provide students with a range of musical experiences and will enhance their personal and music ability in performance.

The Students will have the opportunity to be involved in instrumental music ensembles such as Concert Band or String Ensemble and/or music ensembles such as Contemporary or Rock Bands. These ensembles will rehearse before or after school for 1 hour. Students may choose to be involved in multiple ensembles depending on their skills, interests and availability.

- Develop performance and composition skills in numerous music genres.
- Encourage leadership and collaboration
- Develop creativity and critical thinking skills
